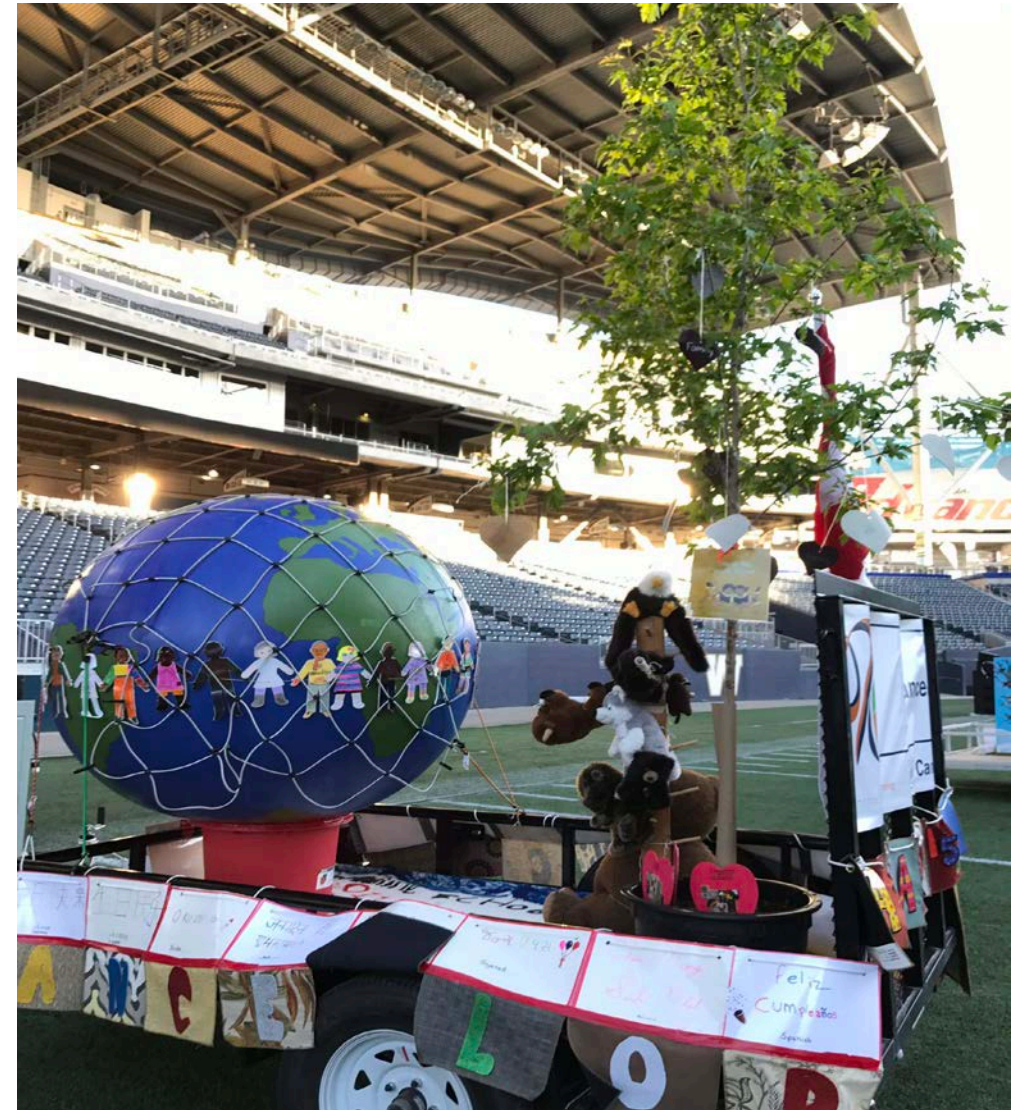

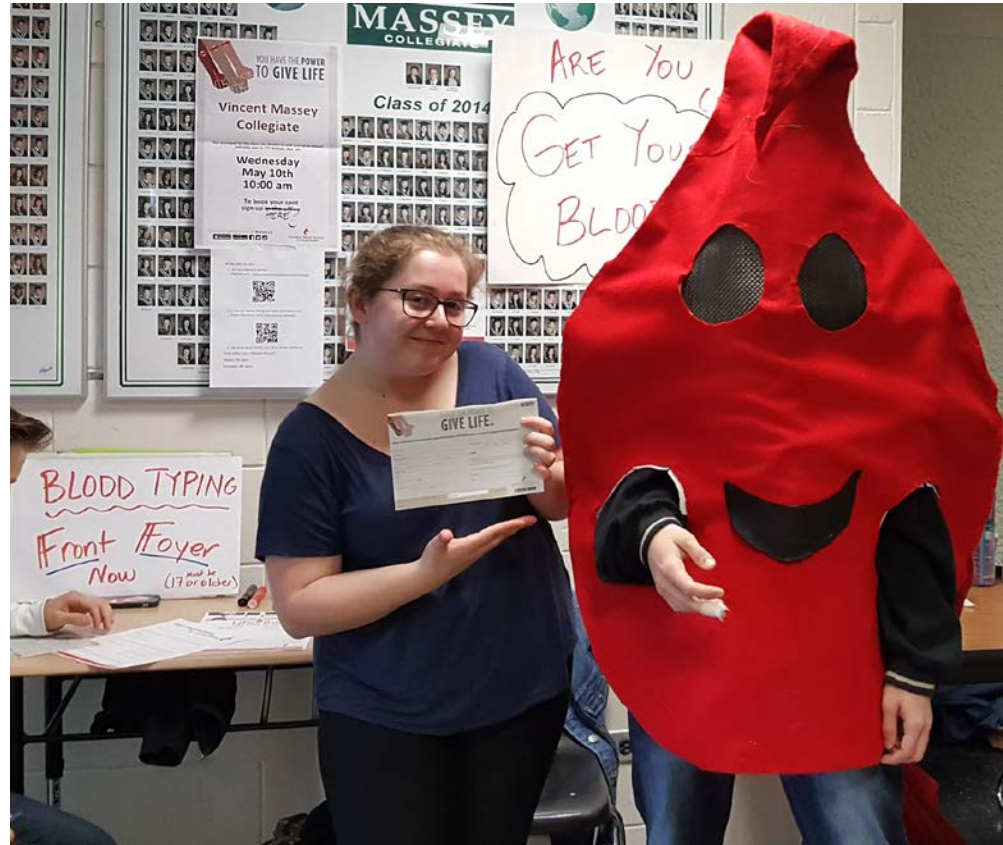
Canadian Blood Services: **Blood Shuttle**

blood

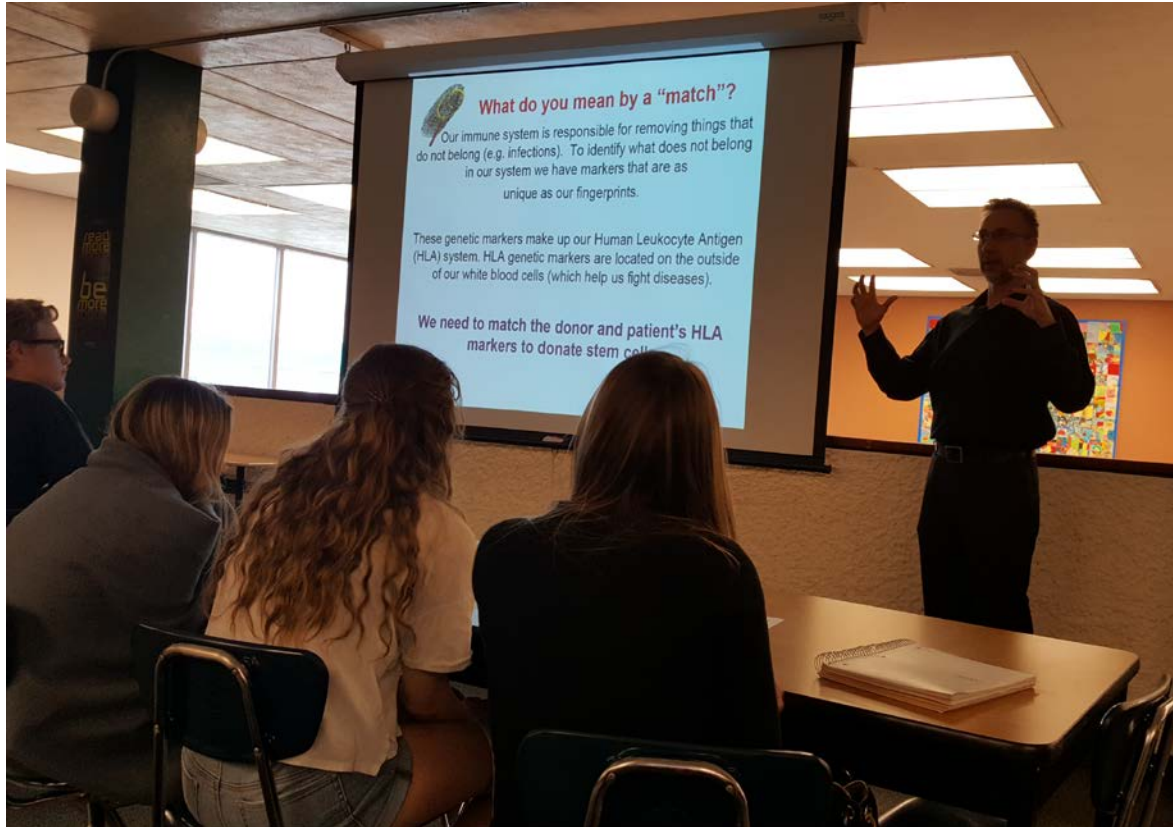


Canadian Blood Services: **Blood Typing**

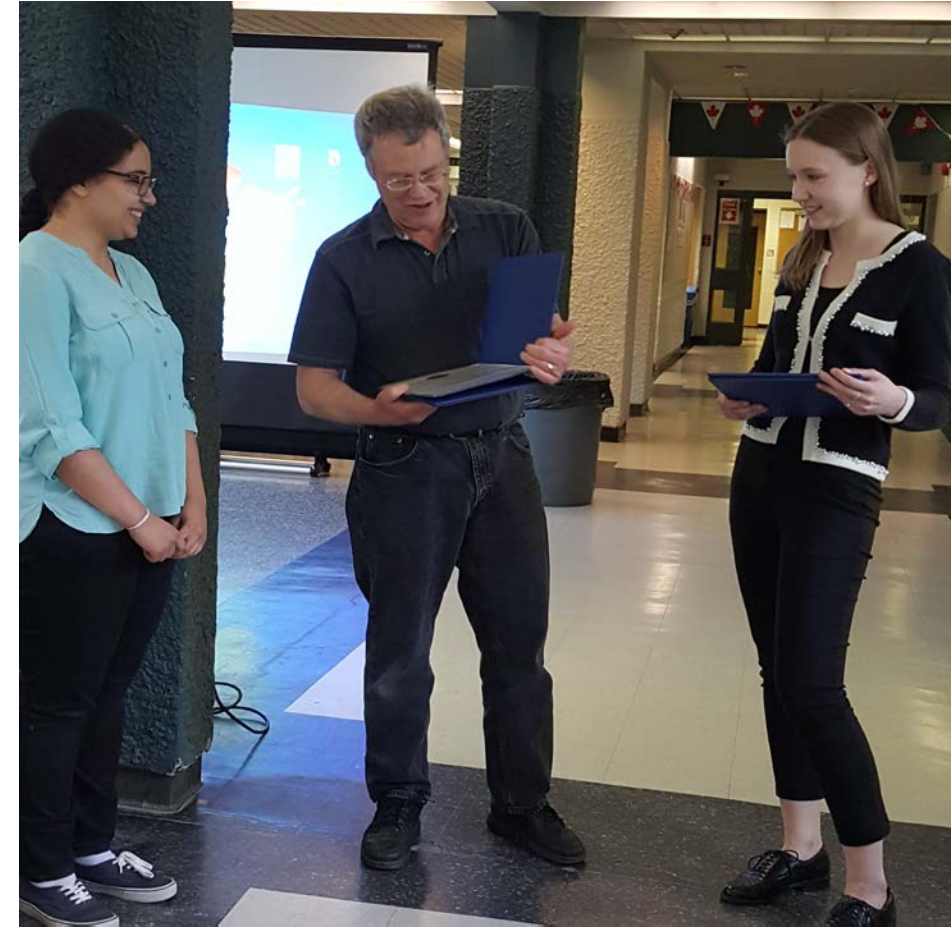
